## Basic WordPress Interview Questions

### 1. What is WordPress?

WordPress is an open-source CMS that allows users to create and manage websites easily. It is written in PHP and uses a MySQL database.

### 2. What are the key features of WordPress?

- Easy to use
- Customizable themes & plugins
- SEO-friendly
- Media management
- Mobile responsiveness

### 3. What are the differences between WordPress.org and WordPress.com?

- **WordPress.org:** Self-hosted, full control, requires web hosting.
- **WordPress.com:** Hosted, limited customization, free with restrictions.

### 4. How do you install WordPress?

- Download from [wordpress.org](https://wordpress.org)
- Upload to a server via FTP
- Create a database
- Run the installation script (`wp-admin/install.php`)

### 5. What are WordPress themes?

Themes control the look and feel of a WordPress website.

### 6. How do you install a theme in WordPress?

- Dashboard → Appearance → Themes → Add New → Install → Activate

### 7. What are WordPress plugins?

Plugins extend WordPress functionality without modifying core files.

### 8. How do you install a plugin in WordPress?

- Dashboard → Plugins → Add New → Search & Install

### 9. What are WordPress widgets?

Widgets are small modules that can be added to sidebars, footers, and widget-ready areas.

A shortcode is a small snippet wrapped in square brackets (`[shortcode]`) that executes custom functions.

### How do you create a shortcode?

function my_shortcode() {
```

return "Hello, this is a custom shortcode!";
}
add_shortcode('greeting', 'my_shortcode');
```

Use a plugin like "WPS Hide Login" or modify `.htaccess`.

## 31. How do you create a 301 redirect in WordPress?

A 301 redirect permanently redirects an old URL to a new one. You can do this using:

**Method 1: Using a Plugin**

- Install and activate the Redirection plugin.
- Go to Tools → Redirection and set up your redirect.

#### Method 2: Editing .htaccess File

Add the following code to your **.htaccess** file:

Redirect 301 /old-page https://yourwebsite.com/new-page

#### Method 3: Using functions.php

```
function custom_redirect() {
    if (is_page('old-page')) {
        wp_redirect('https://yourwebsite.com/new-page', 301);
        exit();
    }
}
add_action('template_redirect', 'custom_redirect');
```

### 32. What is **wp\_enqueue\_script()**?

**wp\_enqueue\_script()** is a function used to properly load and manage JavaScript files in WordPress.

Example Usage:

```
function custom_scripts() {
    wp_enqueue_script('my-script', get_template_directory_uri() . '/js/custom.js',
    array('jquery'), '1.0.0', true);
}
add_action('wp_enqueue_scripts', 'custom_scripts');
```

- The function ensures scripts are loaded only when needed and avoids conflicts.
- 

### 33. What is **wp\_head()**?

The **wp\_head()** function is used to insert essential scripts, styles, and metadata into the **<head>** section of a WordPress theme.

Usage in **header.php** file:

```
<head>
    <?php wp_head(); ?>
</head>
```

- It loads stylesheets, meta tags, and scripts added by WordPress and plugins.
- 

### 34. How do you schedule posts in WordPress?

1. In the Post Editor, click on the "Publish" button dropdown.
  2. Select "Schedule" instead of "Publish Immediately."
  3. Set the desired date and time.
  4. Click "Schedule."

### 35. How do you prevent spam in WordPress?

- Use Akismet Anti-Spam Plugin
  - Enable reCAPTCHA on forms
  - Limit comments and enable moderation
  - Use a plugin like Antispam Bee
- 

### 36. What is a WordPress nonce?

A nonce (Number Used Once) is a security token used to protect forms and URLs from CSRF attacks.

Example Usage:

```
<?php wp_nonce_field('my_action', 'my_nonce'); ?>
```

To verify the nonce:

```
if (!wp_verify_nonce($_POST['my_nonce'], 'my_action')) {  
    die('Security check failed');  
}
```

### 37. How do you add custom fields in WordPress?

- Go to Post Editor → Screen Options → Enable Custom Fields.
- Add a new field (name & value).
- Retrieve it using PHP:

```
<?php echo get_post_meta(get_the_ID(), 'custom_field_name', true); ?>
```

### 38. How do you remove "Powered by WordPress" from the footer?

#### Method 1: Using Theme Customizer

- Go to Appearance → Customize → Footer.

#### Method 2: Editing `footer.php`

Locate and remove:

```
<p>Powered by <a href="https://wordpress.org/">WordPress</a></p>
```

### 39. What is lazy loading in WordPress?

Lazy loading delays image loading until they are visible on the screen, improving website speed.

#### How to Enable Lazy Loading?

- WordPress has built-in lazy loading (WordPress 5.5+).
  - Use a plugin like Lazy Load by WP Rocket.
- 

### 40. How do you create a sticky post in WordPress?

1. Edit a Post → Open Document Settings.
  2. Under Visibility, select "Stick to the top of the blog."
  3. Click Update.

- Install Wordfence or iThemes Security
- Enable reCAPTCHA for login forms

Add `.htaccess` protection:

```

Allow from YOUR_IP  
</Files>
```

- Add `style.css` and `index.php`

Register theme in `style.css`:

```

```

## 65. How do you enqueue a custom stylesheet?

```
function my_theme_styles() {  
    wp_enqueue_style('custom-style', get_stylesheet_uri());  
}

function custom_sidebar() {  
    register_sidebar(array(

## 67. How do you create a custom page template?

- Create `custom-template.php`

Add this at the top:

```
